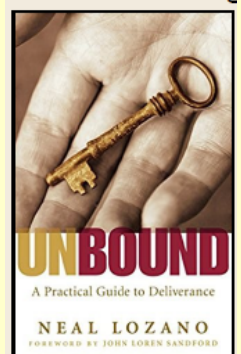

EUCARISTIA ...
Milagro de Amor



Hola mis queridos hermanos en Cristo. "Cristo ha Resucitado, en verdad Resucitó". Nuevamente con ustedes y deseo invitarles a seguir nuestra reflexión sobre este maravilloso tema: "Eucaristía, Milagro de Amor".

LITURGIA EUCARISTICA

El tema que nos proponemos desarrollar nos sitúa en el corazón de la misa. Al referirse al sacrosanto misterio de la eucaristía, dice el Concilio Vaticano II: "En la última cena, en la noche en que fue entregado, nuestro Salvador instituyó el Sacrificio Eucarístico de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre. Por su medio, El perpetúa por todos los siglos, hasta que vuelva, el Sacrificio de la cruz, confiando de esta manera a la Iglesia, su amada Esposa, el memorial de su Muerte y Resurrección: sacramento de piedad, signo de unidad, vínculo de caridad, banquete pascual, en el que Cristo se nos da como alimento, el espíritu se llena de gracia y se nos da una prenda de la gloria futura.

Por esto, la Iglesia con diligente solicitud procura que los fieles no asistan a este misterio de fe como extraños o espectadores mudos, sino que se preocupa porque bien compenetrados con las ceremonias y las oraciones, participen conscientes, piadosos y activamente de la acción sagrada, sean instruidos por la Palabra de Dios, saciados en la mesa del Cuerpo del Señor y den gracias a Dios. Y aprendan a ofrecerse a sí mismos en la ofrenda de la hostia inmaculada, no sólo por manos del sacerdote, sino también junto con él y así, teniendo a Cristo como mediador, se perfeccionen día por día en la unión con Dios y entre sí, para que finalmente, Dios sea todo en todos" (SC 47 y 48)

¡Qué tesoro tan precioso encierra esta enseñanza del Concilio! "Cristo, realmente, tomó el pan y el cáliz, dió gracias, partió el pan y lo repartió a sus discípulos, diciéndoles: tomen, coman, beban: esto es mi Cuerpo, esta es la copa de mi Sangre. Hagan esto en memoria mía. Por ello, la Iglesia ha dispuesto toda la celebración de la liturgia eucarística en partes que corresponden a las palabras y gestos de Cristo. En efecto:

1) en la preparación de las ofrendas se llevan al altar el pan y el vino con agua, o sea, los mismos elementos que Cristo tomó en sus manos; 2) en la Plegaria Eucarística se da gracias a Dios por toda la obra de salvación, y las ofrendas se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo; 3) por medio de la fracción del mismo pan se pone de manifiesto la unidad de los fieles, y por la comunión reciben el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor como lo recibieron los discípulos de manos del propio Cristo". Por tal razón, la liturgia eucarística se compone de tres partes o momentos: la preparación de las ofrendas, la Plegaria Eucarística y el rito de comunión.

A) PREPARACION DE LAS OFRENDAS

1. La misa como cena del Señor:

Los primeros nombres que los cristianos dieron a la misa fueron "fracción del pan" y "cena del Señor", como también se le llamó "Banquete Pascual".

Jesucristo instituyó el sacrificio en la última cena, en el ambiente de una cena pascual de los judíos, que desde entonces se convirtió en la cena pascual de los cristianos. Por esta razón el altar del sacrificio cristiano tiene la forma de una mesa. Celebramos una cena fraternal, una cena pascual. Tenemos la mesa, los manteles, los vasos sagrados, los ingredientes esenciales de una cena el pan y el vino mezclado con agua; las palabras de Cristo *tomen y coman y tomen y beban*; la mención explícita a la participación del mismo pan y el mismo cáliz que se hacen después de la consagración; y, finalmente, la fracción del pan y la comunión. Todo dentro de una gran sobriedad...
