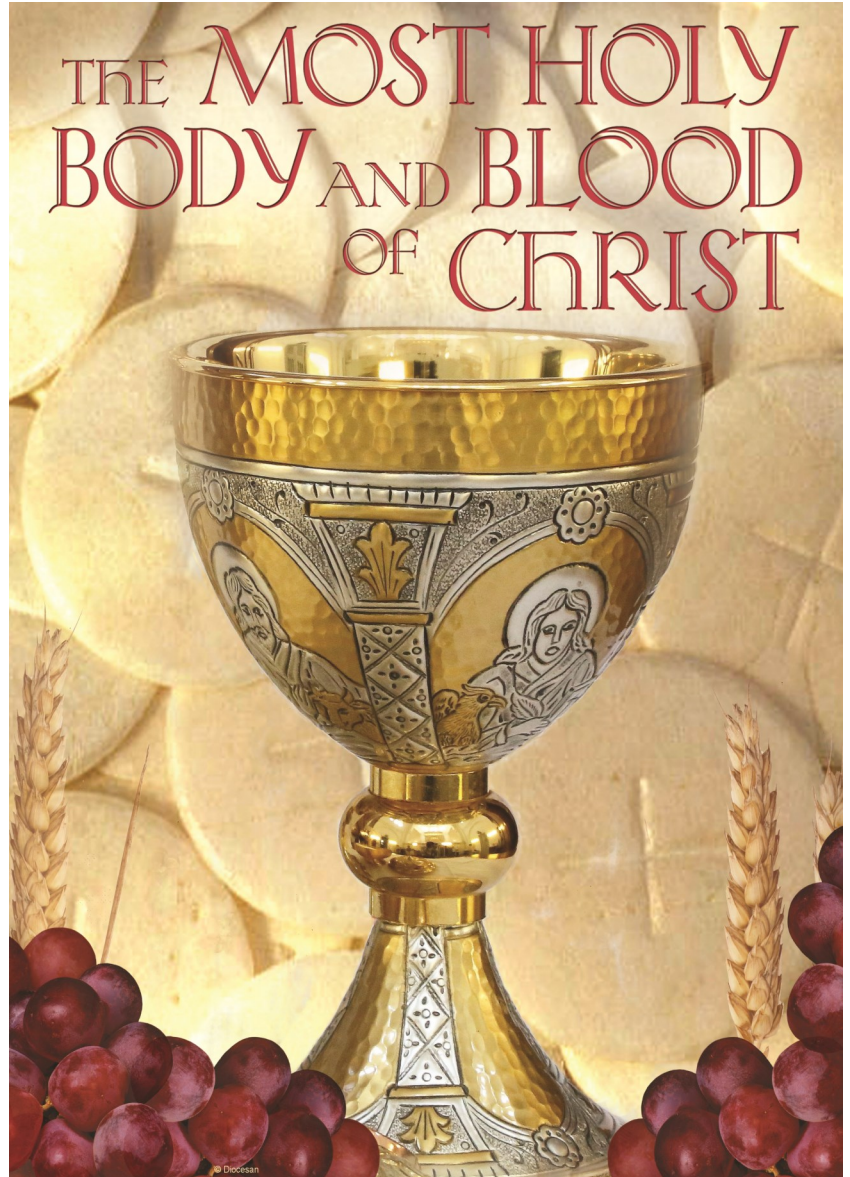

Jesus believed that they could feed the people if they tried but the disciples didn't have that same faith in themselves.
