Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

In sacramental marriage we are called to live with Christ-like love; an authentic love that is free, total, faithful and fruitful. In support of this call to married fruitfulness, the Church proposes Natural Family Planning (NFP) as a modern, scientific method available to couples for planning their families by enabling them to participate in God's creative action without breaking the inseparable link between the unitive and procreative meanings of the conjugal (marital) act. As NFP becomes a way of life, the couple cooperates with each other and God in responsibly planning their family without the devastating spiritual and physical harm caused by artificial contraceptive methods.

Natural Family Planning Awareness week, the annual national educational campaign sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), is a wonderful opportunity for us to share the good news about God's perfect design for marriage and responsible parenting. This year, Natural Family Planning (NFP) Awareness week will be celebrated from July 21 through July 27 under the theme: *Love, Naturally!* During this week we are called to *Celebrate and reverence God's vision of human sexuality*. This week also celebrates the 51st anniversary of the papal encyclical *Humanae Vitae*. In his *Humanae Vitae* Encyclical, Pope Paul VI prophetically articulates the grave consequences of the use of artificial and illicit means of birth control which include a general lowering of morality, increased infidelity, and devaluing of women (*HV*, no. 17). One only needs to scan today's headlines to confirm the devastating accuracy of his predictions and discern the destructive consequences for families. In contrast, couples who practice NFP enjoy greater marital stability and experience divorce at only one-tenth the rate of divorce among first time marriages.

During NFP Awareness Week, I would like to thank those married couples who live out their marriage commitment to free, total, faithful and fruitful love. I encourage all married couples and those preparing for marriage to reflect on their current or future marriages and how they can authentically and responsibly fulfill their commitment to fruitful love. En el matrimonio sacramental estamos llamados a vivir con un amor semejante al de Cristo; un auténtico amor libre, total, fiel y fructífero. En apoyo a este llamado a la fecundidad matrimonial, la Iglesia propone la Planificación Familiar Natural (PFN) como un método moderno y científico a disposición de las parejas para planificar sus familias permitiéndoles participar en la acción creativa de Dios sin romper el vínculo inseparable entre los significados unitivo y procreativo del acto conyugal (marital). A medida que la Planificación Familiar Natural (PFN) se convierte en una forma de vida, la pareja colabora entre sí y con Dios para planificar responsablemente su familia sin el devastador daño espiritual y físico causado por los métodos anticonceptivos artificiales.

La semana de concientización de la Planificación Familiar Natural, la campaña educativa nacional anual patrocinada por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB), es una excelente oportunidad para que compartamos las buenas noticias sobre el diseño perfecto de Dios para el matrimonio y la crianza responsable. Este año, la semana de concientización de la Planificación Familiar Natural (PFN) se celebrará del 21 al 27 de julio con el tema: ¡Ama, naturalmente! Durante esta semana, estamos llamados a Celebrar y reverenciar la visión de Dios sobre la sexualidad huma. Esta semana también se celebra el aniversario número 51 de la encíclica papal De la Vida Humana. En su encíclica De la Vida Humana, el Papa Pablo VI articula proféticamente las graves consecuencias del uso de métodos artificiales e ilícitos de control de la natalidad, que incluyen una reducción general de la moralidad, un aumento de la infidelidad y la devaluación de las mujeres (HV, no. 17). Solo hay que escanear los titulares de hoy para confirmar la exactitud devastadora de sus predicciones y discernir las consecuencias destructivas para las familias. En contraste, las parejas que practican la PFN disfrutan de una mayor estabilidad matrimonial y experimentan el divorcio en una décima parte del índice de divorcios entre los matrimonios por primera vez.

Durante la Semana de Concientización de la PFN, me gustaría agradecer a aquellas parejas casadas que viven su compromiso matrimonial con un amor libre, total, fiel y fructífero. Animo a todas las parejas casadas y a aquellas que se preparan para el matrimonio a reflexionar sobre sus matrimonios actuales o futuros y cómo pueden cumplir de manera auténtica y responsable su compromiso con el amor fructífero.
