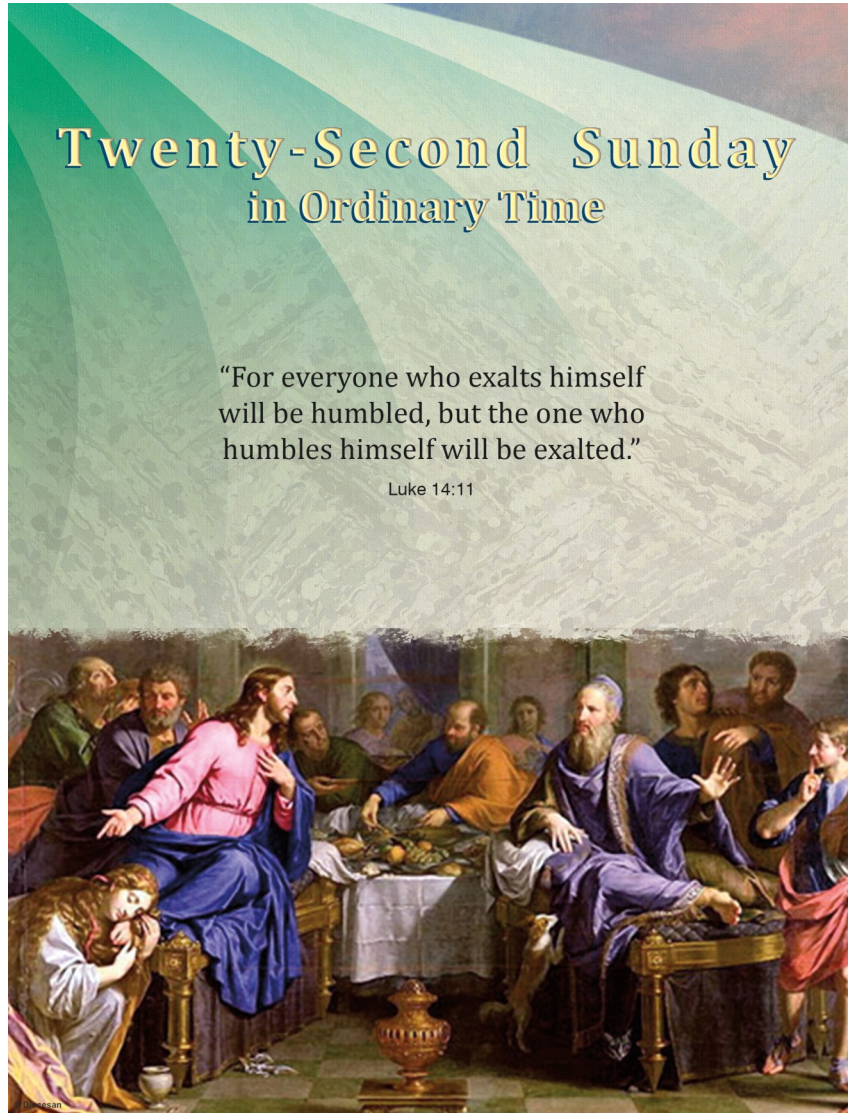

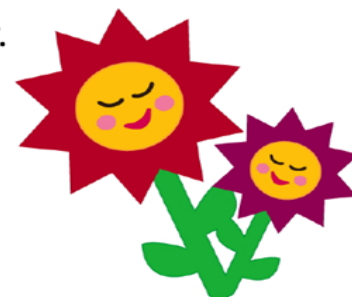
WOMEN'S GUILD NEWS
