Respect Life Sunday 2019

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

On Sunday, October 6, we celebrate *Respect Life Sunday*. The theme for this year's Respect Life program is *Christ Our Hope in Every Season of Life*. *Respect Life Sunday* is an occasion at the beginning of October, dedicated to respect for life, to renew and invigorate our efforts to foster a respect for life within our society at every stage from the moment of conception until natural death. This year in itself has brought with it many of devastating events in terms of various state legislation promoting and expanding the availability of abortion even beyond what was envisioned in its legalization in *Roe v. Wade*. There is no respect for life if the life of an unborn child is not respected and protected. This is also evident in other areas regarding the protection of life which this year have taken even more drastic diversions such as in regard to legalization of matters pertaining to assisted suicide. Life is a gift from God and it is not only our responsibility but our privilege to love and respect it as God intended it to be.

While abortion is a fundamental issue which must be given primary attention, this does not in any way lessen the attention that must be given to so many other areas of respect for life. Pope Francis made that clear this year in his determination that the death penalty is "inadmissible" in our present context in which the protection of society can be insured without the need to take someone's life. Pope Francis has also been very inspiring in addressing so many other areas that are part of our respect for life including the protection of those with disabilities, the elderly, the poor, the immigrant, those discriminated against, the outcast, those on the periphery, and so many other individuals whose lives have equal dignity. As we renew our efforts to encourage our legislators to put an end to abortion, we also do all we can to promote the dignity of life of every person made in the image and likeness of God. God's gift of His life to us is a reminder that He has a human face in us.

I am deeply grateful to the faithful of our Diocese for the staunch and loyal support you give to engendering respect for life.

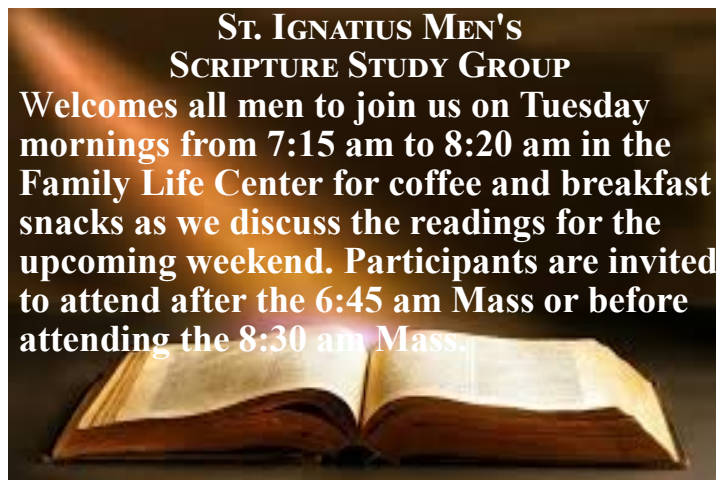

### Knights of Columbus Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest



**Theme: Discuss the meaning of Virtue and how you live and embody the virtue of Charity.**

*"Charity is the theological virtue which we love God above all things for his own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God"* - Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1822

Biblically, virtue is understood as the conformity of life and conduct with the principles of morality, while Charity signifies the reciprocal love between God and man, one that is manifest in unselfish love and eloquently shown in the life, teachings, and death of Jesus Christ. *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it, you shall love your neighbor as yourself"* (Matthew 22:37-39).

In an essay of 500-750 words, consider the meaning of virtue and think about ways in which you exemplify the virtue of Charity to glorify and reflect the nature of God. This could be at home with your families or in your communities, as you enrich the welfare of others. There will be different prizes for different levels (Scholarships, gift certificates, plaques, trophies etc.) The top three international level winners for each grade will receive monetary awards: \$300 for 1st place, and \$100 each for two runner-up in each grade level.
