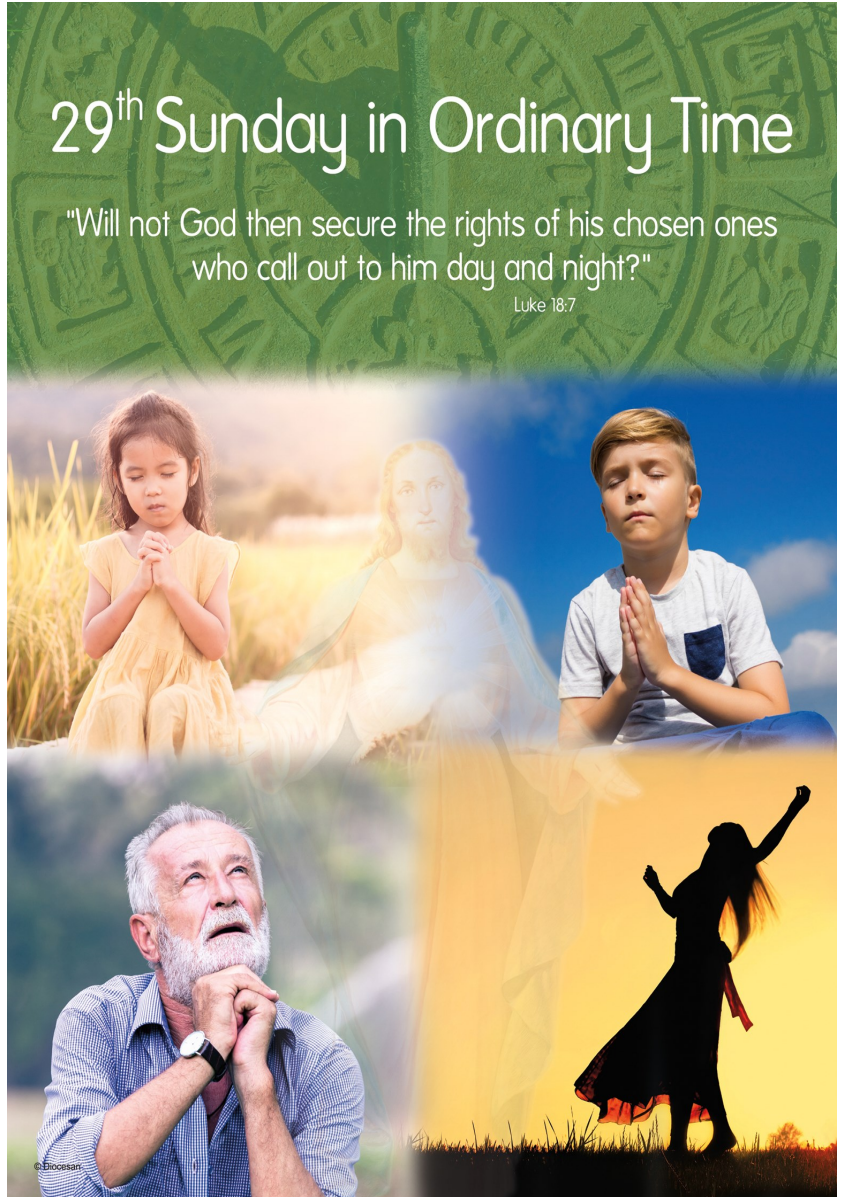

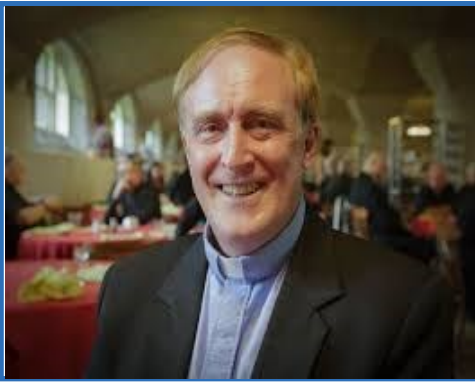

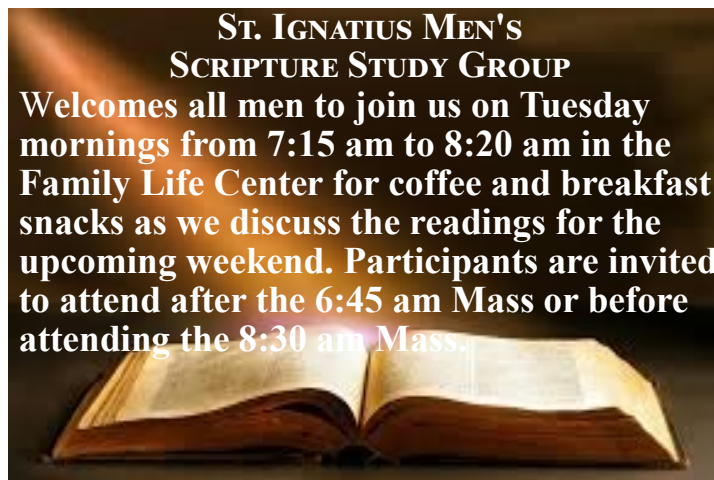

### CHILDREN’S LITURGY OF THE WORD

What is it? How can you help?

It is a program for children in which the Sunday Scripture readings are proclaimed and explained on a level appropriate to children during our Sunday 10:30 a.m. Mass seasonally. We currently need adults to teach the parish young children. Leaders are scheduled on a rotating basis; detailed resources for preparation and reflection are provided, as well as shadowing our more experienced Catechists. There is a Diocesan Screening process all volunteers who assist children need to do. ### Knights of Columbus Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest



**Theme: Discuss the meaning of Virtue and how you live and embody the virtue of Charity.**

*“Charity is the theological virtue which we love God above all things for his own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God”* - Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1822

Biblically, virtue is understood as the conformity of life and conduct with the principles of morality, while Charity signifies the reciprocal love between God and man, one that is manifest in unselfish love and eloquently shown in the life, teachings, and death of Jesus Christ. *“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it, you shall love your neighbor as yourself”* (Matthew 22:37-39).

In an essay of 500-750 words, consider the meaning of virtue and think about ways in which you exemplify the virtue of Charity to glorify and reflect the nature of God. This could be at home with your families or in your communities, as you enrich the welfare of others. There will be different prizes for different levels (Scholarships, gift certificates, plaques, trophies etc.) The top three international level winners for each grade will receive monetary awards: \$300 for 1st place, and \$100 each for two runner-up in each grade level. Checks are accompanied by a framed certificate. Teens interested within grades 8th – 12th, can contact Dee in the youth office for more information.
