Since 1954, Veterans Day has been observed in our country on November 11th to honor those men and women who have served the nation in the military services. We are blessed in the Diocese of Palm Beach by the presence of so many veterans among the faithful in our diocesan family and we are grateful to them for their selfless act of service to the nation, to our brothers and sisters and for the ideals we hold so dear.

To better assist the needs of the Catholic faithful in our military services, the Archdiocese of the Military Services (AMS) was formed in 1986 by Pope Saint John Paul II and is responsible for the pastoral care of all uniformed personnel stationed on military bases, both domestically and abroad, and all those serving in embassies, consulates and diplomatic missions.

The AMS provides the sacraments, faith formation and other ministries to the more than 1.5 million Catholics currently serving in the armed forces, their families, those studying at the military academies and those cared for at Veterans Administration Medical Centers around the country. To assist the ministry of the AMS, a special collection is taken every three years to help with ministry costs and will be taken the weekend of November 16th and 17th.

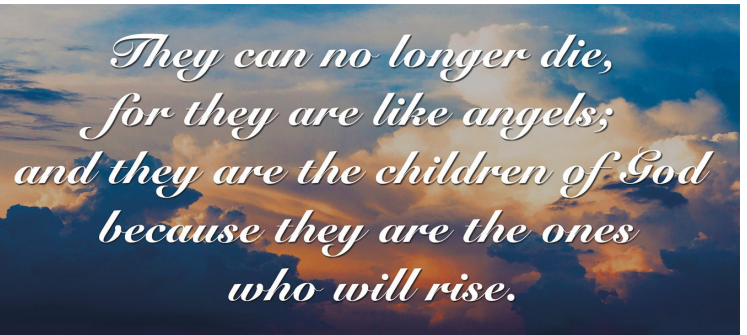

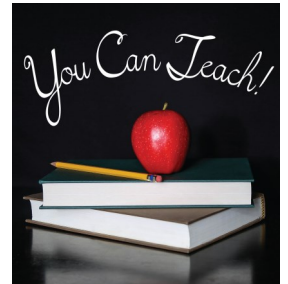
