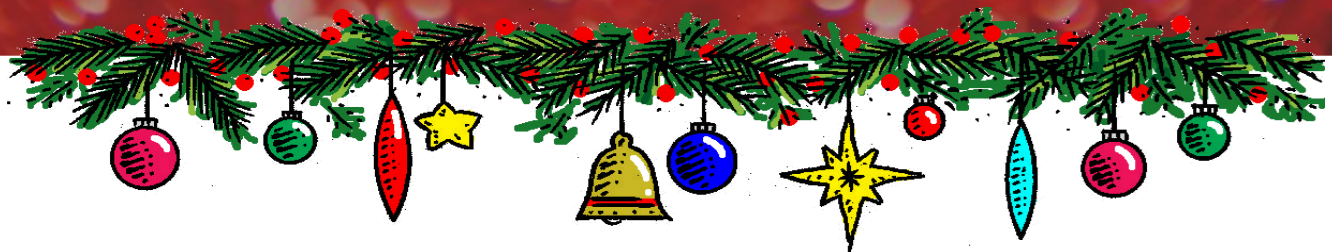

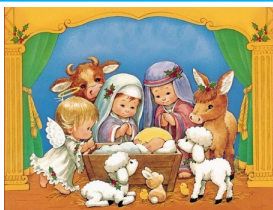
CONFIRMATION CLASS INFO.

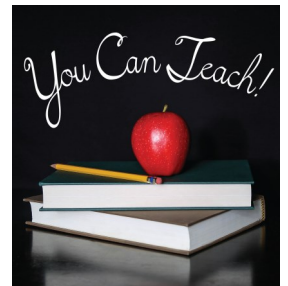
