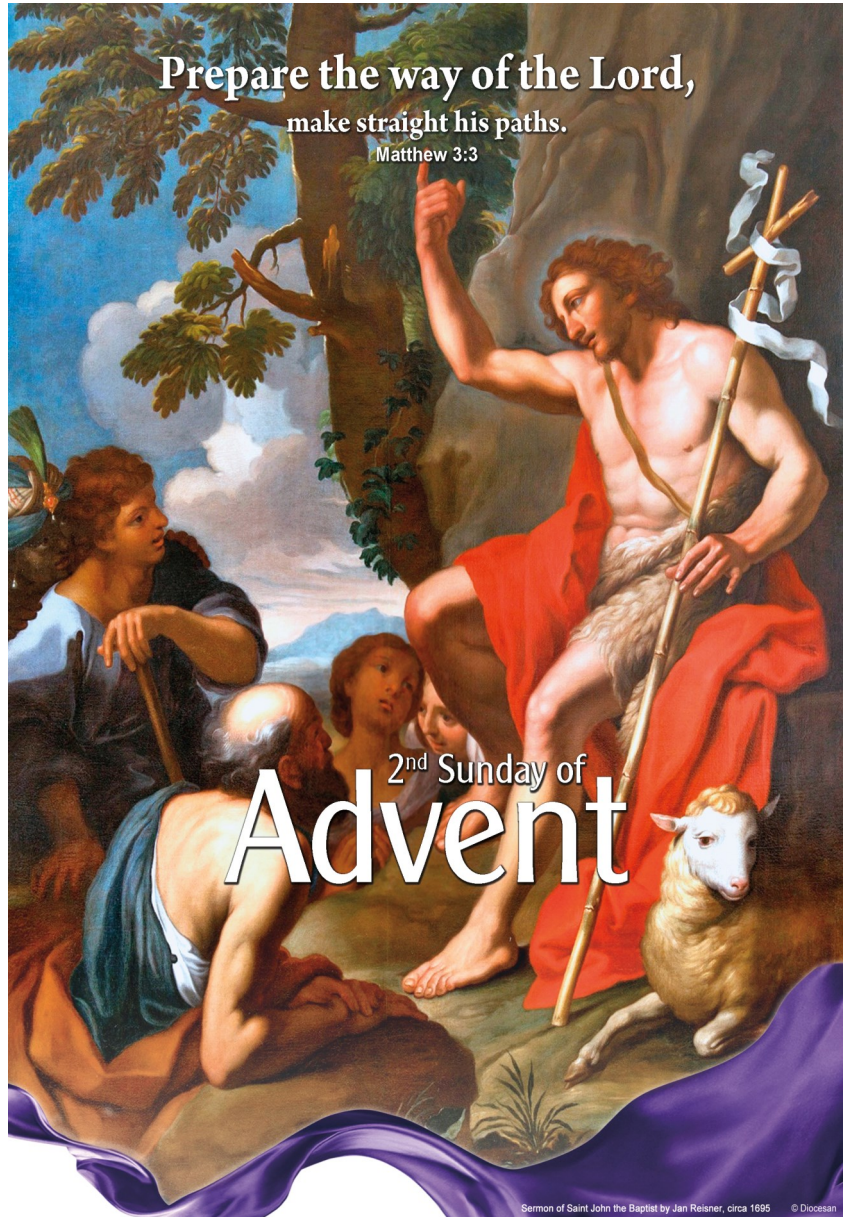

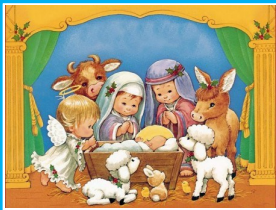
## CONFIRMATION CLASS INFO.
