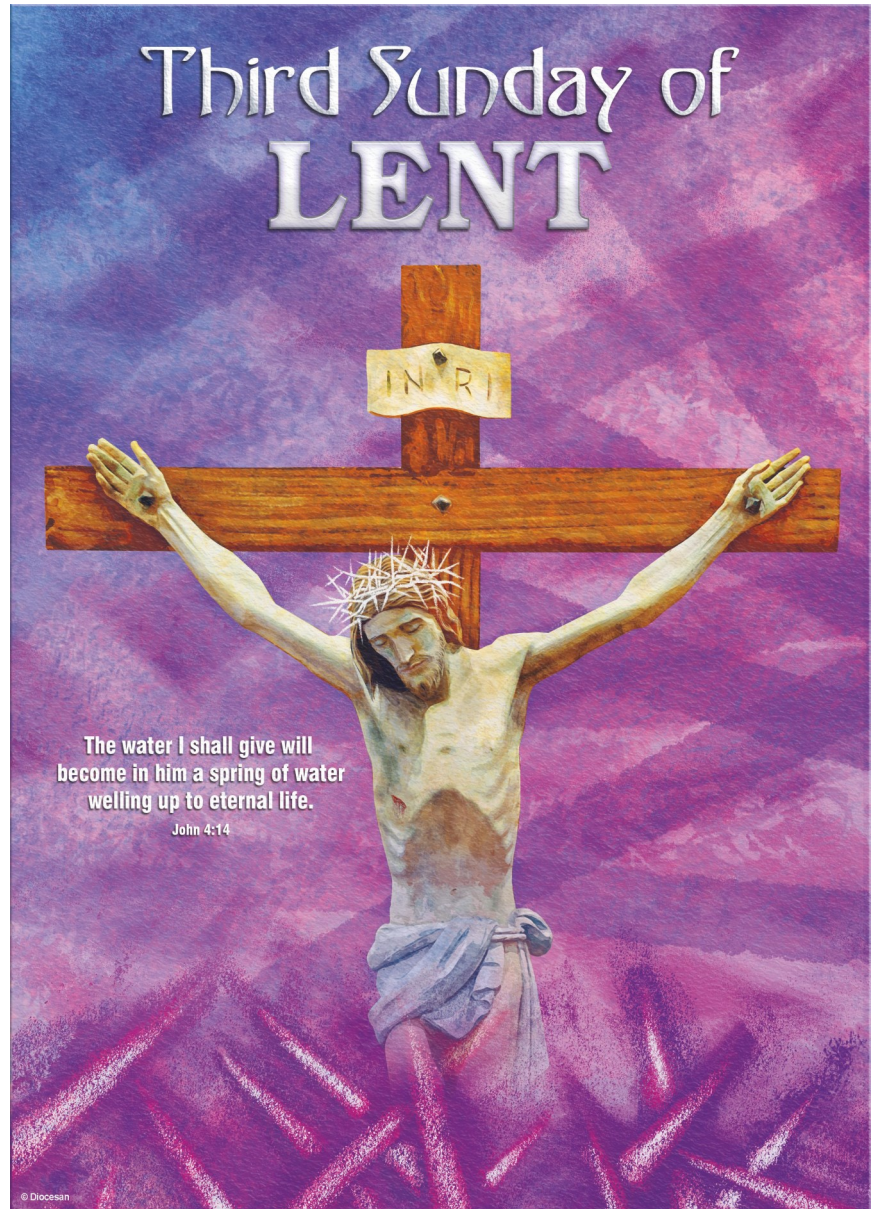

WHAT IS ABSTINENCE?

Abstinence is refraining from eating meat. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.

Ash Wednesday | Good Friday

DAYS OF ABSTINENCE?

Ash Wednesday | All Fridays of Lent | Good Friday

WHO ARE REQUIRED?

Catholics from age <18 to 59>

The sick are excused from fasting

WHO ARE REQUIRED?

Mandatory for everyone older than 14 years old

WHEN IS THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY?

Florida's Presidential Primary is on **March 17, 2020**. The deadline for voters to register to vote or update their party affiliation was on February 18, 2020. Eligible voters can vote in the Primary by mail, by voting early, or by voting at the polls on Election Day. **Who can vote in the Presidential Preference Primary?** Florida's Presidential Preference Primary is a closed-primary election. This means that you must be a registered with one of Florida's major political parties in order to be eligible to vote. However, local nonpartisan elections may be held at the same time as the Primary Election. In those elections, all eligible voters can vote for those local races. FLU SEASON AND CORONAVIRUS (SARS-CoV-2/COVID-19)

Each year during flu season the Diocese of Palm Beach offers guidelines to the parishes to help prevent the spread of contagion. We here at St. Ignatius have made the decision to implement the following precautions:

- Temporary suspension of the minor chalices used for the distribution of the Precious Blood.
- Temporary suspension of the communal Sign of Peace (kissing or shaking of hands).
- Not to hold hands during the recitation /chanting of the Our Father.
- Emptying of the holy water fonts at church doors.
- Use of anti-bacterial soap by the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion before and after distribution of the host.
- Reminder to parishioners that if you feel unwell or have flu like symptoms are encouraged to seek medical attention and stay home.
- Celebrant is to use discretion if he shakes hands while greeting parishioners before or after the Mass.

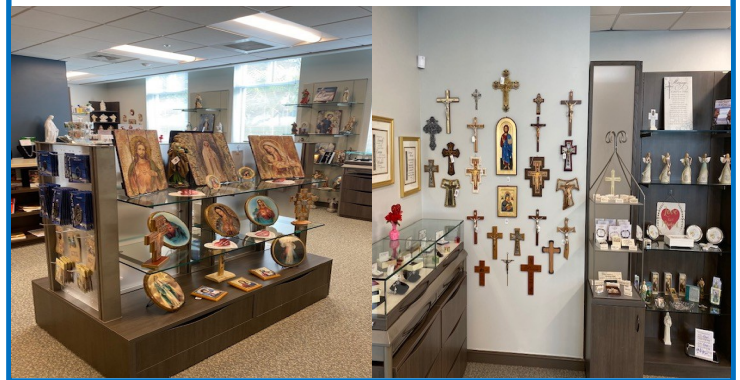

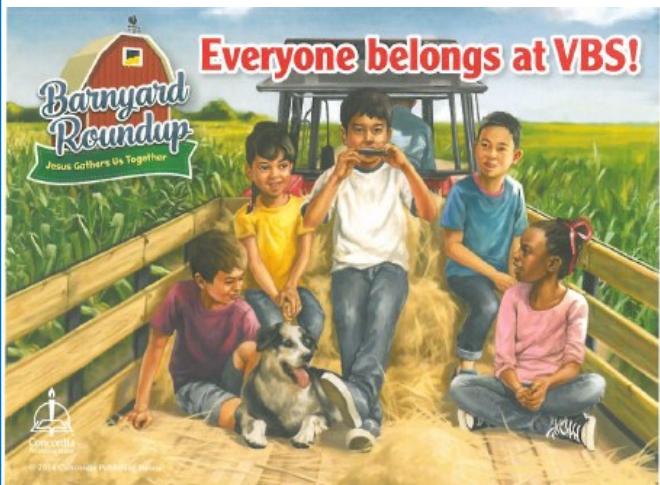

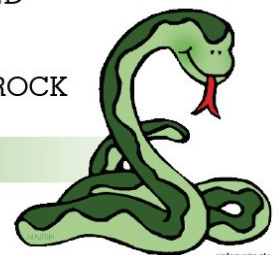

LA DIÓCESIS DE PALM BEACH CONTINÚA
MONITOREANDO LOS DESARROLLOS
RELACIONADOS CON EL CORONAVIRUS
Marzo 3, 2020

Aunque actualmente no hay brotes conocidos o infecciones locales en el área de la Diócesis de Palm Beach, la diócesis continúa monitoreando de cerca los desarrollos relacionados con el coronavirus (COVID-19). Los protocolos para emergencias médicas se revisan y actualizan según sea necesario de conformidad con los Centros para el Control de Enfermedades (CDC) y el Departamento de Salud de Florida. Tome las medidas de precaución para prevenir la propagación de la infección respiratoria. Los CDC sugieren acciones como evitar el contacto cercano con personas enfermas; evitar tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca; quédese en casa cuando esté enfermo; cubra su tos o estornudo con un pañuelo desechable, luego tírelo a la basura; limpie y desinfecte los objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia con un spray o toalla de limpieza doméstica; y lávese las manos a menudo con agua y jabón durante al menos 20 segundos.

Las precauciones que las parroquias pueden emplear, a discreción del párroco, incluyen la suspensión temporal de 1) los cálices utilizados para la distribución de la Preciosa Sangre, 2) el Signo comunal de la paz (besar o estrechar las manos) y, 3) saludo antes de la misa. Las parroquias también pueden vaciar las fuentes de agua bendita en la entrada de la iglesia y pueden fomentar el uso del jabón antibacterial por parte de los Ministros Extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión antes y después de la distribución de la comunión. Además, los feligreses pueden optar por no tomarse de las manos durante la recitación / canto del Padre Nuestro. Aún queda a discreción del comulgante cómo desea recibir la Comunión. Como la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión implica el contacto tanto con la boca como con las manos, a cualquier Ministro Extraordinario de la Sagrada Comunión que se sienta incómodo distribuyendo la Comunión se le debe permitir abandonar temporalmente el ministerio.

Es importante recordar que, si está enfermo, se le recomienda que se quede en casa. El Ministerio de la Misa Católica Televisada de la Diócesis de Palm Beach está disponible para la comunidad si no puede asistir a la Misa. La Misa Católica Televisada se puede encontrar en CW34 a las 10:30 am todos los domingos, en www.DiocesePBSchools.org o en Facebook en @DiocesePB.

La Diócesis de Palm Beach continuará abordando las preocupaciones relacionadas con el coronavirus, incluida la promoción de la conciencia e iniciando respuestas adicionales si es necesario.
